More recently, in 2017 he won First Place award at the Colonie Arts League Juried Art Exhibit in the Cooperstown Regional Juried Art Exhibit (Mary Buckley Memorial Prize for Oil) and the Lake Placid Center for the Arts Juried Show (First Place). In 2018 he won first place for Oil at the Hagaman Art Show. In 2019 Fred won third Prize at the Ticonderoga Harvest Plein Air Festival and Honorable Mention Judges Circle at the Colonie Juried Art Exhibit. In 2020, Fred was juried into numerous shows and won second prize at the Colonie Pruyn Museum Juried Art Show.

Fred is currently showing his work at the TiArts Downtown Gallery in Ticonderoga, NY, the NorthCountryArts Gallery in the Shirt Factory in Glens Falls, NY and other venues throughout the Adirondacks and the New York Capital Region.
