Originally from Spain, Lana Privitera graduated in 1983 from the Fine Arts School of Zaragoza, where she majored in Fashion Design and Art History. After working in Advertising for a few years, she moved to the USA in the early 1990s.

Mrs. Privitera returned to painting and art competitions in 2014 and is known nowadays for her colorful and luminous watercolors full of intricate detail.

She chose transparent watercolor as her medium not only because of the ethereal and luminous effects artists are able to achieve with it, but for its satisfying immediacy as well.

In a short time, Mrs. Privitera's paintings have gathered a long list of awards in watercolor competitions both nationally and internationally. Her work has also been featured in diverse publications – both in the USA and abroad – since her return to the art world.

She is a Signature Member of the National Watercolor Society, the North East Watercolor Society, the Central NY Watercolor Society and the Philadelphia Watercolor Society -among others.

Mrs. Privitera has been an art instructor for over 15 years and offers workshops and Demos inside and outside of the USA. Locally, she is a watercolor instructor at the Wallkill River School of Art in Montgomery, NY.
